



The Oconto Area Chamber of Commerce is taking on the project of the construction of a pedestrian bridge across the Oconto River. As long as most Oconto citizens can remember, there has been this idea of a pedestrian bridge to Holtwood Park but due to differing factors as to the location of the bridge, it was never built. With advanced development of the park both as a campsite and recreational area along with the development of the commercial area on STH 22 and Business 41, a bridge to the park would be a tremendous benefit to the citizens of Oconto.

The proposed bridge would be a standard width pedestrian structure located between Bond Park and Holtwood Park at the west end of Bond Park. This location was selected because it would not interfere with camping sites and would give access to both the campers and recreational park users.

The Chamber has documentation that a bridge can be constructed for approximately one million dollars with a large portion of the cost coming from government grants. The Chamber is asking for pledges now to see if we can meet our financial obligation before we spend a large sum of money on detailed design. The pledges would not be due until construction begins. A successful campaign now could mean that design & construction could start sometime in 2018. Please show your support for this worthwhile project. Donations are tax deductible.
